



Thank you for your interest in providing a foster home to an equine from MHARF. To ensure that our animals receive proper care while in a foster home, we do have a number of requirements for the approval process. We strive to make the best possible horse/foster home match so that we can make this the most positive experience for people and animals alike. Attached you will find a copy of our Foster Guidelines. Please note that these are simply guidelines and that we may be able make exceptions on a case-by-case basis depending on the individual animal. A short introduction to yourself: experience level, how many other animals you own, whether you keep your animals at home or board at another facility (if you use a boarding facility we will need the info and pics for that facility), whether you have fostered or adopted from a rescue organization before, whether you know anyone who has adopted from or fostered for MHARF in the past, and who you use as a veterinarian and as a farrier.

Is there a particular horse you are interested in fostering? Are you looking for a horse you can ride while fostering? Are you interested in training a fostered horse? If so, do you prefer to just do ground work or are you comfortable with doing under saddle training? Are you looking for a horse just as a companion for another horse? Do you have a preference as to age, size, gender or breed? In what situation would a fostered equine be kept (for example: stabled with turn out, pasture w/ shelter, with how many other equines, etc.)?

Current photographs of your facility or the boarding facility you plan to use: Fencing (all types your horse would come into contact with) and gates, barn/stalls, pastures/paddocks (including shelters), feeders, water source, hay storage and supply, other animals on the property, indoor/outdoor arena and round pen (if applicable).

Is there a time limit for the period you want to foster or is the period open-ended?

Once again, thank you for your interest in giving a rescued equine a place to stay until we are able to find a permanent, loving home!
